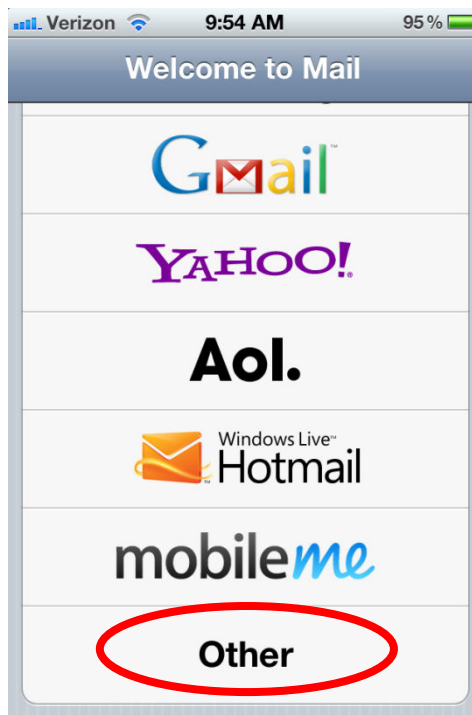


iPhone, iPad, iPod Email Setup Instructions

The following are instructions to setup your MVTV Wireless email in any **Apple based** device.

If this is the first email account you set up on your device simply click on the **MAIL** icon on the bottom of your screen. Once on the **Welcome to Mail** screen, scroll down to the bottom and click on **Other**.

(If you are adding this as an additional account you will need to go to the Settings icon. Then click on **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**. Then click on **Add Account**. Scroll down to the bottom and click on **Other**)



Now Click on **Add Mail Account**



Now enter your information in the fields shown.

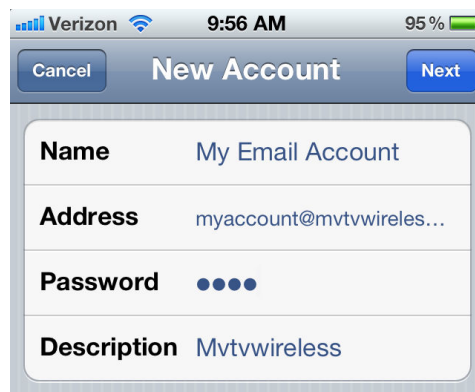
Name: enter your name

Address: enter your MVTV Wireless email address

Password: enter the password for your email address

Description: use default or rename at will

Click on **Next** when you are done entering your information



MVTV Wireless email is a **POP** account. Please be sure to select **POP**.

Now you will need to fill in the Mail Server information:
The information for both the incoming and outgoing mail server is the same.

Host Name: `imap.mvtvwireless.com`

User Name: enter your email name without `@mvtvwireless.com`

Password: enter your email password

Click on **Save** when you are done entering this information
